- Provides an energy efficiency handbook/ e-learning programme for its crews.
- Issued instructions and procedures which ensure safe operation of all vessels in regard to environmental protection complying with mandatory international, national and local rules and regulations.
- Meets all applicable legal requirements and even exceeds them: Zeaborn Ship Management received the ISO 14001:2015 (Environmental Management System) certification by DNV GL, ISO/IEC 27001 (Information Security Management System) certification by RINA, owns the Environmental Passport (for 8,500 teu and 13,100 teu vessels)
- Established an internal and external benchmarking system in order to improve continuously.
- Promotes further technological innovations on board of its vessels, under management regarding environmental protection and corresponding change management.
- Executed different redesign measures to reduce fuel consumption and CO₂-emissions of all vessels under management and promotes further development of the design of the vessels to meet energy performance targets.
- Expects that our suppliers and subcontractors implement and maintain a suitable environmental management system to minimize environmental impact and hazards.
- Support and advise our ship owning clients to follow the ratification of the Hong Kong International Convention for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships ('Hong Kong Convention') and to be in full compliance with the European Union Regulation 1257/2013 (Ship Recycling Regulation "SRR") when it comes to the recycling of ships.
